Station1 continues to receive new funds for additional fellowship slots. Applications continue to be accepted on a rolling basis.

The Station1 Frontiers Fellowship (SFF) is a prestigious, fully-funded ten-week summer experience for undergraduate students focused on socially-directed science and technology education, research, and innovation. A unique internationally-recognized model of higher education, the SFF includes an exciting research internship in emerging areas of science and technology with leading established and startup partner companies, research institutes, and nonprofit organizations, a cross-interdisciplinary shared curriculum, and personal and professional advancement activities including inclusive leadership and collaboration, scientific and technical communication, networking, and more. Station1 coordinates an exceptional portfolio of internship research projects in all science and technology majors, including, for example, areas such as biotechnology and public health (e.g. tissue engineering, marine genomics, synthetic biology, AI/ML diagnostics, circular biomaterials), civic technologies, environmental and clean technologies, inclusive digital networks and media, and sustainable advanced manufacturing and next generation infrastructure. SFF 2022 will be in a fully virtual format and students will participate remotely in all program activities from their city of residence.

Eligibility Criteria Applicants must:

- Be currently enrolled in an undergraduate degree-granting program at an accredited post-secondary institution;
- Have a genuine interest in science and technology applied to societal impact;
- Be available to participate full-time in hours compatible with program activity time zones for the entire duration of the program (tentative dates: June 6th - August 12th, 2022);

- Have no other employment or volunteer work (full-time or part-time) or participating in academic classes for the full duration of the program; and
- Be comfortable communicating in English (the working language for the program) and fill out application materials in English.

Station1 strongly encourages students from minoritized backgrounds, first generation to college, low socioeconomic backgrounds, those enrolled at minority-serving institutions and community colleges, or who have not had the opportunity to participate in previous research, internship, or project-based learning to apply.

Station1 encourages students who may have applied previously but were not accepted to apply again as an increased number of fellowships are expected to be available. There have been cases of students who were not accepted on the first application but were accepted subsequently.

While Station1 would like to continue to engage with students from previous cohorts, Station1 Fellows alumni are not eligible to participate in the Station1 Frontier Fellowships again.

This application contains approximately 70 questions, including 5 essay questions and 2 required PDF documents (i.e. resume and unofficial transcript).
